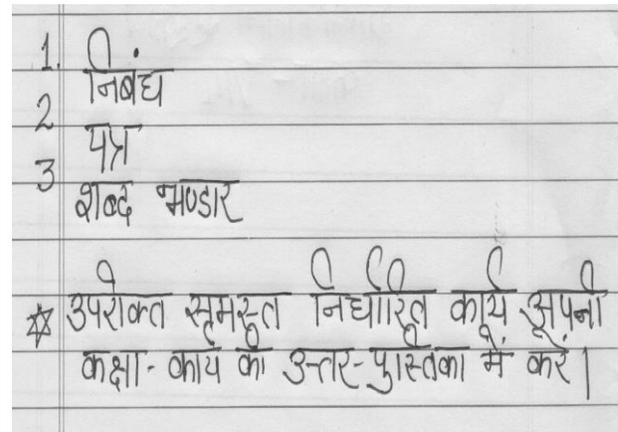

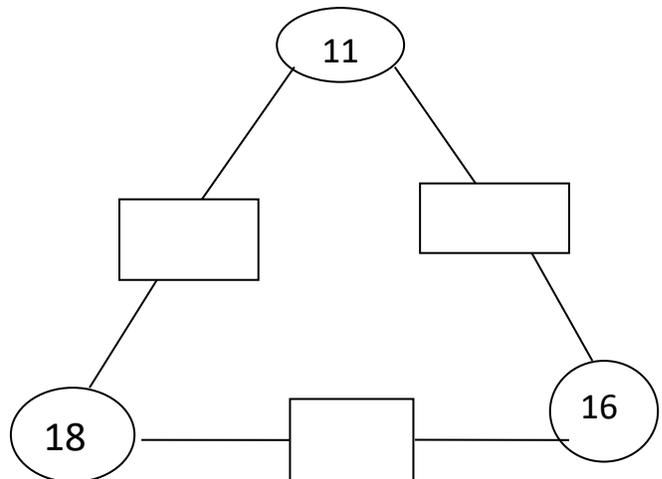
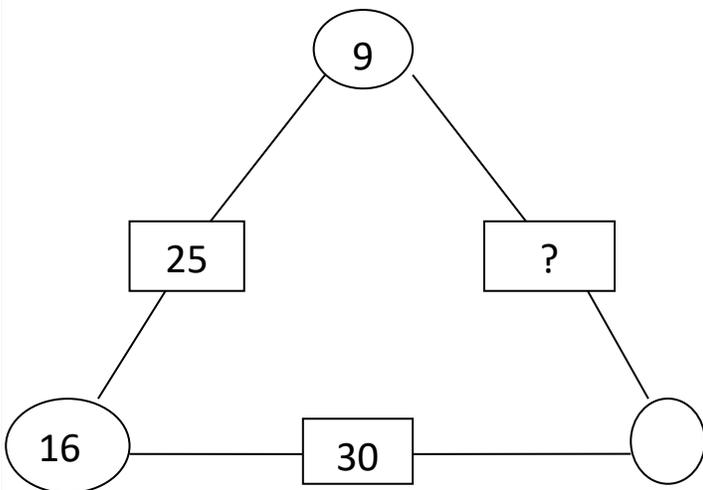

**Q2:- Arithmogon Triangle Puzzle**



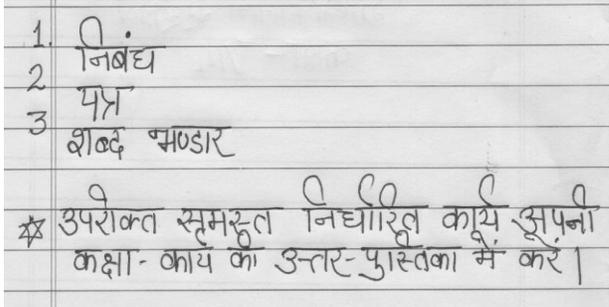
